Absences

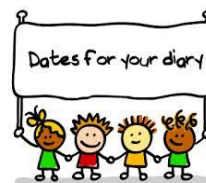
Thank you again to the parents who contact us when their child is off ill. This is a tremendous help to us when updating our attendance records.
